Aldi	<p>Every Monday to Saturday, Aldi stores will open 30 minutes prior to their usual opening times for elderly and most vulnerable customers, to ensure that they can shop as safely as possible.</p> <p>https://www.aldi.co.uk/covid19-FAQ</p>	<p>From Tuesday 14th April, Aldi are extending their priority shopping time for emergency workers which will now include all groups entitled to a Blue Light card.</p> <p>This includes all social care workers, first responders, St John's Ambulance staff and Age UK volunteers, amongst many others.</p> <p>These groups, alongside the NHS, Police and Fire Service, will be given exclusive access to stores 30 minutes before normal opening on Sundays.</p>
